
GREEN INFRASTRUCTURE



- The development parcels have been informed by a comprehensive landscape and visual appraisal which seeks to ensure that proposed built form is located within visually contained areas of the site and is also arranged positively within both the existing robust landscape framework that already exists, as well as within proposed attractive open space and proposed Green Infrastructure, which is also sympathetic and sensitive to its setting and character, resulting in positive place making.
- The landscape strategy for the site seeks to maximise the Biodiversity Net Gain (BNG) on the site through providing wildflower meadow, mixed scrub and open grassland and woodlands/new tree planting to enhance the habitats that already exist.
- A holistic management strategy will be prepared and submitted as part of the planning application to reassure the decision makers that the long term management and maintenance of both existing and proposed landscape features and open space (in terms of ecology, drainage, arboriculture and landscape amenity) has been considered from the outset.
